# PLAYERS/PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

## I. Objectives

- A. To learn the value of the team concept
- B. To develop fundamental softball skills
- C. To develop personal confidence, character and pride

## II. Rules

- A. Players will be expected to:
  - i. Conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner
    - 1. No swearing
    - 2. No uncontrolled emotional outburst
    - 3. No “Dirty Play”
  - ii. Be on time and attend all practices. Players must notify coaches of all up coming absences in advance of practice or games.
  - iii. Take care of equipment

## III. Infractions of Code of Conduct

- A. Uncontrolled emotions, anger and swearing
- B. Unsportsman like/negative attitude and/or conduct i.e.
  - i. Intentionally throwing at batters or any other player
  - ii. Dangerous actions such as throwing equipment
  - iii. “Dirty Play”
- C. Tardiness at practice or games
- D. Unexcused absence from practice or games
- E. Smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages or use of controlled substances while in uniform on or off the field
- F. Fighting
- G. Umpire abuse
- H. Abusive behavior, language or attitude towards team players.

## IV. Penalty for Infractions

- A. May result in counseling, suspension or removal from team and/or league.
- B. Any action will be taken by the board and the decision will be final.
